Community Guidelines

At Collabung, our diverse community is constantly growing and we strive to ensure that all members feel safe, secure, and happy, with the opportunity to share their stories. To achieve this goal, we have developed community guidelines that we would like to share with you.

Collabung is a public platform, and everything posted on it, including stories and comments, becomes a part of the public network. Therefore, before posting personal information or ideas, consider whether you are comfortable with anyone on the internet seeing it, including parents and teachers.

It is best to keep personal information private to prevent it from being copied, spread, reposted, or found in unexpected ways. Respect the privacy of other users by not posting their private information.

We encourage constructive communication among Collabung members but remind you to consider the impact of your messages. If you are uncomfortable with another user's posts or comments, you can delete their comments from your profile and block them. If you are experiencing a serious problem with another user, please report it to us.

If you are worried about a friend who may be dealing with bullying, depression, or self-harm, offering them support can make a big difference. However, if you believe that their safety is at risk, it's important to report it to the Collabung team.

If you are facing challenges in your own life, don't hesitate to talk to a trusted adult, whether it's a parent, teacher, or friend. It's essential to remember that cyberbullying is just as serious as physical bullying, and you should always speak to a trusted adult if you or someone you know is being bullied online.

Report any abusive posts or violations that you come across. Keep your password secure and never share it with anyone, including individuals who claim to be Collabung staff. Avoid sharing any personal, identifying information, and be sure to review our Code of Conduct and Content Guidelines. Lastly, remember that Collabung users must be at least 13 years of age.
